

Preparation of Papers for ICSES 2008 (24pt)

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Abstract—This document describes how to prepare papers for 2008 International Conference on Signals and Electronic Systems. Please follow the recommendation as closely as possible in order to create high-quality proceedings with common formatting for all papers (9pt boldface).

I. INTRODUCTION (10PT SMALL CAPS)

Authors are kindly encouraged to submit papers on signals or electronic systems to ICSES 2008.

Please prepare your four page paper according to the instructions given in this document and send it via ICSES 2008 website interface not later than May 3, 2008. Only electronic submission in pdf format is accepted.

After successful evaluation of the paper, the author will be requested to send the four page final camera-ready updated (according to the reviewers' suggestions) version in pdf format for the conference proceedings not later than July 31, 2008. Each paper will additionally undergo technical review prior to the final acceptance.

II. PREPARATION OF PAPERS BY STYLE AND TEMPLATE

A. For *LaTeX* Users(10pt italic)

LaTeX document class `IEEEtran`, for PC and Mac available in file `IEEEtran.zip` and for Unix available in file `IEEEtran.tar.gz`, with only one option conference automatically formats the manuscript in accordance with the conference requirements. Paper [1] can help you to use the `IEEEtran` class. File `instr_ICSES08.zip` is intended to serve as 'starter file'. You need to cut our text and then insert your one

In order to properly format bibliography please use bibliography style for PC and Mac available in file `IEEEtranBST.zip` and for Unix available in file `IEEEtranBST.tar.gz`.

Do not adjust lengths that control margins, column widths, etc. Do not use packages that alter fonts (such as `pslatex`). In order to make the title of the paper use instruction `\title{\vspace*{17mm}}...`.

After formatting please check if your paper fulfills directions presented in this paper

B. For MS Word Users

File `instr_ICSES08.doc` is intended to serve as 'starter file'. You need to cut our text and then insert your one into this file.

III. PREPARATION OF PAPERS WITHOUT STYLE AND TEMPLATE

Please use A4 paper format (297mm high and 210mm wide). Set the top and bottom margin to 20mm. Set the left and right margin to 17mm. Use two columns style with 4mm column separation. The paper must not exceed four pages in length. Please do not put page numbers on your paper.

A. Typesetting

1) *Titles*: The title of the paper appears on the first page, centered over both columns and is set in 24 pt Times New Roman normal letters. The title should begin 37mm from the top edge of the page (20mm margin plus 17mm additional space). In invited papers below the title is placed text '(Invited Paper)' centered and written with the Times New Roman 11pt Italic letters. The title of the section is centered over one column and set in 10 pt Times New Roman small caps letters. The title of the subsection is aligned left and set in 10pt Times New Roman Italic letters. The title of the subsubsection is aligned left with the 20pt indentation and set in 10pt Times New Roman Italic letters.

Sections are numbered by Roman numerals with dot, subsections by Italic capital letters with dot and subsubsections by Arabic numerals with bracket. Space between paragraphs and titles of sections and subsections should exceed 6pt.

2) *Authors*: The first name and the last name should be placed under the title and written with the Times New Roman 11 pt fonts.

3) *Affiliations*: Department, institution, street, city, country and e-mail should be placed under the name and set in 10pt Times New Roman fonts. Use a multiple column layout for up to three different affiliations as in this document. For over three affiliations, or if they all won't fit within the width of the page use one column layout. Then the first line should contain the author's names with the signs that point at the appropriate affiliations separated by commas. Use following signs: *, †, ‡.

§, ¶, ||, **, ††, ‡‡, Affiliations should begin with the right signs and be placed below.

4) *Abstract*: The abstract should be written with the 10pt indentation and the bold Times New Roman 9pt fonts. It should not exceed 10 lines and 200 words.

5) *Text*: Main text should be written with the Times New Roman 10 pt fonts. Please do not use Asian fonts as this will make your manuscript unreadable.

First line of each paragraph should be written with 10pt indentation.

B. Abstract

The paper should begin with an abstract shortly describing matter and achieved results.

C. Equations

Equations should be centered, numbered with Arabic numerals in parentheses as in example below

$$H(s) = \frac{1}{s+1} \quad (1)$$

and set in 10 pt letters.

D. Figures

Figures should be numbered in the order of appearance in the paper. The caption begins with the text 'Fig.' and the number of the figure. It is placed below the figure and should be centered over one column and set in 8pt Times New Roman normal letters. Figures are numbered by Arabic numerals with dot. Some figures can span two columns. In such a case the

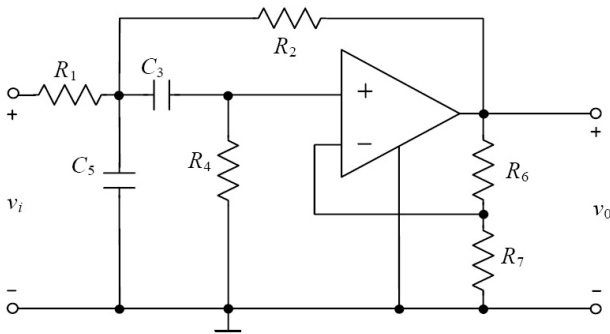


Fig. 1. An example of figure (8pt)

figure should be placed at the top of a page.

You can create figures containing subfigures. Subfigures are numbered by Times New Roman 8pt small letters in brackets.

Please do not include color drawing or photos.

E. Tables

Tables should be numbered in the order of appearance in the paper. The caption should be placed over the table and centered. In the first line written with the Times New Roman 8 pt capital letters is placed text 'TABLE' and the number of the table. The following lines contain text of the caption. They are set in 8 pt Times New Roman small caps letters. Tables are numbered by Roman numerals.

F. References

A list of references should end the paper. It should be titled by text 'REFERENCES' written similarly as title of the section but without numbering. Please number all references with Arabic numerals in square brackets and write with the 8pt letters. References should be listed in the order of appearance in the paper.

Give all authors' names; use "et al." if there are six authors or more. Papers that have not been published, even if they have been submitted for publication, should be cited as "unpublished". Papers that have been accepted for publication should be cited as "in press". In a paper title, capitalize the first word and all other words except for conjunctions, prepositions less than seven letters, and prepositional phrases.

For papers published in translated journals, first give the English citation, then the original foreign-language citation.

IV. PRODUCING PDF FILE

The Adobe Acrobat Distiller (for MS Word users) and pdfLaTeX (for L^AT_EX users) are preferred for creating pdf files. All used fonts (including the standard fonts) applied in your paper must be embedded into the file. After making your file, check if this requirement is fulfilled. In order to do it you need to open File/Document/Properties/Fonts option in Adobe Acrobat Reader. The maximum allowed file size is 5MB. Please do not encrypt your PDF file because we should insert headings and page numbers.

V. CONCLUSIONS

The conclusions should appear in the last numbered section.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

Acknowledgments (use preferred American spelling i.e. without an "e" after the "g") of assistance from any people other than authors (if any) should appear before the list of references headed as unnumbered section. Sponsor acknowledgments may also be put in the unnumbered footnote on the first page.
